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A VOICE THAT ENDURES

Donja Dubrava, where the Mura and Drava rivers become one water. Doors have opened to a voice that has endured for eight centuries – the Međimurje popevka, a vocal heritage inscribed by UNESCO on the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity on 28 November 2018.

Palača međimurske popevke is the first and only interpretation centre in Croatia dedicated to the popevka. Here the popevka does not stand behind glass – it is sung, passed on, taught. In the cellar of the Hirschler Palace, six thematic rooms await you, alongside the voices of more than fifty master transmitters, a listening room, and an AR/VR experience that takes you to a mill on the Mura.

The verse „Narodil nam se" from the 13th century. Žganec's 1908 notation „Megla se kadi". The voices of Teta Liza, Lidija Bajuk, Cecilija Merkač Hudopisk, Patricija Juračić. The modes of pentatonic, Dorian, Lydian, Mixolydian. Verses of love, sorrow, humour, sacred and work.
